


# TOURNAMENT NOTICE & SCHEDULE

<b>WHAT TO DO PRIOR TO THE TOURNAMENT:</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Please ensure all competitors/families have completed and signed the waiver found on the Registration Form. Merge all competitors' registration information onto the Master List.</li> <li>2. Complete the Team Kata Registrations for all competitors that are registered for the event on the Master Registration. <b><u>(All forms required are enclosed)</u></b></li> <li>3. Collect payments from all your clubs' competitors and combine into one complete payment using either cheque or money order made payable to <u>Satewin Karate Club</u></li> </ol>

<b>WHAT TO DO DAY OF THE TOURNAMENT:</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Take attendance-ensure all your students are present.</li> <li>2. Once present, register your club by submitting Individual Registrations with Master Registration attached on the front.</li> <li>3. Include with Registration one cheque or money order totaling the amount on the master registration for all the competitors for your dojo.</li> </ol>
<b>EQUIPMENT:</b>	Kumite competitors must provide their own fist protectors, mouth guards and groin cups. Karate uniform must comply with the guidelines set out in the tournament rules.
<b>ENTRY FEES:</b>	\$30.00/person - Single Event \$50.00/person - Multiple Events  Lunch is included. A concession should also be available during the day.



# SATEWIN TOURNAMENT RULES

The tournament will be run following the rules established by the WKF for tournaments. Event Rules are as follows:

## **Kata competition (individual):**

1. Colored belts may use any kata from their style curriculum.
2. White belts may restart a kata once without penalty.
3. All competitors below the rank of Brown Belt may repeat katas as required.
4. Brown and Black belts may NOT repeat katas.
5. Glasses may be worn as approved by the Chief Official.

## **Kata competition (team):**

1. Teams can be all boys, all girls, or mixed. (There will not be separate divisions)
2. If teams are of mixed rank they will compete in the division of the highest-ranking (belt color) team member.
3. Teams may use any kata from their curriculum.
4. Each team needs to have a Team Name to compete.

## **Kumite competition (individual):**

1. All competitors will compete with freestyle sparring.
2. Events may be combined to give three or more competitors per event. We will do our best to keep the divisions as closely matched as possible.
3. Polycarbonate safety glasses may be worn upon approval by the Chief Official.
4. All competitors are required to wear mouth guards, groin protection, and approved gloves.

## **Flag Kumite (individual)**

1. Competitors must be 4-6 year olds only.
2. All competitors will need mouth guards and groin protection.
